- **7. Treasurer's Report (JD):** Two sets of reports circulated by email ahead of the meeting: one set up to the end of the financial year in April, and another set since then.
  - As of 30th April 2021, balance at the bank is: £34,745.29. This comprises: Restricted funds: £34,140.49; CC Admin fund: £220.50; Windfarm Admin fund: £384.31. The balances of the restricted funds are: BnO: £20,789.61; CnC: £12,310.00; BTWF Community Projects: £931.00; RWE Path: £73.20; Toilet Caretaking: £ 36.68. Expenditure between 23rd March and 30th April 2021: £3,000 to Culrain Hall from CnC. Income since 23rd March 2021: None.

### 8. Ardgay, Creich (Bonar Bridge) & Lairg Community Action Plan

 BW & AM to represent A&DCC on CAP steering group. Funding for community plans will become available from windfarm developments. MT gave recap of recent meeting, introducing the members and discussions about survey questions, priorities, existing locality plans. Karen Derrick from VABS is producing draft of the actions to take forward.

#### 9. Regular updates

#### • Planning issues:

- (i) Comments from local resident re proposed MidFearn distillery & response:

  Correspondence received from resident concerned re: effluent being discharged into
  Dornoch Firth and reply from Developer. A&DCC will monitor planning as it develops.
- (ii) Application for Section 36 Windfarm near Rogart on planning list, boundary with Creich. Exhibition 18th May.
- Climate Issues: Email update provided by Anna Patfield: Highland Climate Festival will be held on 25th June to 4th July. Aiming to organise local events such as nature walks; kid's events; community planters; carbon cafes; films etc.; and wider events to publicise and take part in. Highland Adapts' Community Climate Advocates team have been working on climate charter for community leaders (and others) to hopefully sign up to. KoSDT seed/garden swap day to be held on Saturday 14th May. Also discussing local community compost (hotbin) pilot and how that may best be implemented.

## Windfarms:

- Sallachy approved by North Planning Committee, bringing prospect of shared ownership one step closer. Possibly a first for Scotland, hopefully a model for future.
- o **Meall Buidhe**: further photomontages available on their website.
- Achany extension: more information available about changes including removal of 2 turbines. BW has USB available if anyone wants to view.
- Croick, Braelangwell, Strath Oykel are in A&DCC area.
- Kyle of Sutherland Development Trust: No report available, David Watson on annual leave.

Highland Council: Council elections last week: 2 new councillors for Ward 1: Michael Baird (LibDem) and Marianne Hutchison (SNP) and 1 returning councillor Hugh Morrison (Independent). Power sharing arrangement to be decided soon. MB updated on speed restrictions on Bonar Straight. Toilets open again at South Bonar. BW asked MB about his position on Gledfield Development as he signed petition objecting to development. MB stated his objection focussed primarily on issues with SEPA, Scottish Water. MT to forward CC's position/submission to MB. ACTION MT
